In the event that an applicant cannot be placed, due to a course being full or not meeting the minimum enrollment, the application and tuition fee will be returned. **NO REFUNDS** are given after the start of the session.

All classes will meet at Tremont Elementary School. Please see inside cover for directions.

All classes will be held from 9 a.m. to 12 noon.

All classes meet Monday through Friday with the exception of Band and Orchestra which will meet three times per week. Please see course description for details.

Students are expected to be on time, attend courses at all prescribed times, and bring noted, required materials.

Children must be picked up and signed out by the parent/guardian or by his or her designee of record. Anyone picking up a child, including parents or guardians, must present a driver's license for identification purposes.

Students are encouraged to bring a small snack for break times.

Four Week Courses

July 13 - August 7

#1 BAND

JULY 13 – AUGUST 7

GRADES 5 & 6

This **4 week** course is designed for students who have participated in either Grade 4 or Grade 5 Band.. Students will be given the opportunity to expand their knowledge of their instrument while having fun. Each student will meet every week for 1 large group rehearsal **AND** for two additional lesson times per week. (Lesson times are approximately 40 – 50 minutes long and may be scheduled any day of the week.) You will be contacted after minimum enrollment has been reached to schedule dates and times of lessons. Children must bring their instrument to the class each rental. Rental is the responsibility of the parent and not included in this course.

#2 ORCHESTRA

JULY 13 – AUGUST 7

GRADES 5 & 6

This **4 week** course is designed for students who have participated in either Grade 4 or Grade 5 Orchestra. Students will be given the opportunity to expand their knowledge of their instrument while having fun. Each student will meet every week for 1 large group rehearsal **AND** for two additional lesson times per week. (Lesson times are approximately 40 – 50 minutes long and may be scheduled any day of the week.) You will be contacted after minimum enrollment has been reached to schedule dates and times of lessons. Children must bring their instrument to the class each rental. Rental is the responsibility of the parent and not included in this course.

#3 CHORUS I

JULY 13 – JULY 24

GRADES 4 - 6

This program will allow children to gain an appreciation of music and performing. A major focus will be on the proper methods for choral singing, as well as providing students with an outlet to perform in front of an audience, bolster their self-confidence and share in the joy of performing with others on stage. Featured will be theater games, singing and simple dance. A recital/performance at the end of this two week program will be planned to add motivation, joy and a sense of achievement.

#4 DOLL DAYS OF JULY 13 – JULY 24 SUMMER

GRADES 1 - 6
