

I.D. Cards

All students will be issued a free I.D. card entering 9th grade and are expected to carry their cards at all times throughout their years at Patchogue-Medford High School. If lost, damaged, worn, and/or inoperable there will be a \$3.00 fee for replacement. These cards are necessary for various reasons during the school day including the following:

1. Entering the building. (Attendance is taken when students enter the building.)
2. Entering the school library and checking out books from the library
3. Identification at all school functions (e.g. dances, sporting events).
4. Identification of Patchogue-Medford students from non-students who enter the high school building or who are on school grounds without proper authorization.
5. Seniors who are leaving high school building with permission.
6. For all exams such as the PSAT, SAT or ACT exam, Midterms, Regents, and Finals
7. Cafeteria Use.
8. Purchasing of tickets for any school sponsored events and admission to school events.
