

Immunizations

According to the Public Health and Education laws of New York State, students who do not meet all immunization requirements will not be permitted to enroll in school. Schools are required to conduct an annual survey of the immunization levels of all children entering and attending school to increase the children's protection from serious vaccine-preventable communicable diseases.

The necessary immunizations include:

Immunization Requirements for Grade 9 - 12 Students

VACCINE	REQUIRED
DTP/DTaP	3 doses
Tdap	1 dose
Polio	4 doses or 3 doses if 3rd was received at 4 yrs. old
MMR (2 Measels/1 Mumps/1 Rubella)	2 doses
Hep B	3 doses or 2 doses of adult hepatitis B vaccine
Varicella	1 dose
Meningococcal conjugate (MenACWY)	Grade 12: 2 doses or 1 dose of the dose was received at age 16 or older. Grade 9 & 10: 1 dose
