



Student applies to colleges


CA * SUNY * Institutional * SCCC * Coalition counselor may help you decide which is best for you to use

Student enters colleges in NAVIANCE


For Common App Schools: Students will match the account with Naviance

For Non-Common App Schools: Students must enter each college manually

- •Student requests transcripts/teacher recs in NAVIANCE
- Student monitors progress in NAVIANCE
- Student records outcomes & requests final transcript for chosen college in NAVIANCE

Points to Consider...

- •Use same Name & email in NAVIANCE & college apps
 Use only full legal name
- •Common Application (CA) applications automatically sync in NAVIANCE via Matching Process




Non-Common App Schools








Letters of Recommendation...



Add Request

FAFSA Changes

Projected to open in December (delayed from the usual Oct 1 open date)

The form will be shorter (fewer questions)

The language will be closely aligned with the language on income tax returns

The SAI (Student Aid Index) replaces the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) and contains new formulas for calculating eligibility.

Having multiple children in college will no longer reduce SAI, (may result in reduced aid)

Qualified 529 distributions from grandparents, etc. will not reduce aid

Education savings accounts will only be counted if designated for the specific student. (ESAs for other children won't be considered.)

Eligibility for the Pell Grant is expanded to families earning 225% of the poverty line (so about \$67,500 for a family of four)

For divorced parents, families will need to report the parent who provides the most financial support for the child (previously, they reported the parent that the child resided with more often)

FAFSA Highlights

Number of Questions

Going from 100 to roughly 30

Name Change

Expected Family Contribution (EFC) is now known as Student Aid Index (SAI)

Pell Grant

The maximum award is going from roughly \$6,700 to \$7,400

There will be a reduction in award for students who are not full time

Discount eliminated for multiple children

The amount of children in college no longer impacts aid

Divorced Parents

It used to be that the custodial parent had to be the one on the FAFSA It is now the parent that provides the financial support

Financial Support from Others is no longer taken into Consideration

If financial support is 50/50, it may default to parent with highest adjusted gross income

If you receive a gift or 529 from a grandparent, it will no longer impact your ability to receive aid

Income Protection Goes Up

The income protection for both parents and students has gone up

Timeline of Senior Events: September



Review your transcript to make sure there are no errors

Fill out a transcript release form and return it to the guidance office

Work on completing college applications and essays

If you have not done so already, ask one or two teachers for letters of recommendation through Naviance

Early Decision and Early Action candidates - make sure your counselor is aware of your deadlines

Register for your final SAT/ACT if needed, and send your scores through the testing site to the colleges you are applying

Attend financial aid workshops

Check the Guidance Newsletter for monthly scholarships and attend financial aid workshops

Register with NCAA if you plan to play a Division 1 or 2 sport in college

Keep your grades up! Most colleges will want to see your Senior year mid-year grades

Timeline of Senior Events: October/November



Complete your college essay and speak with your English teacher to help you review it

Discuss your college plan with your counselor and finalize your college list

Early Decision candidates should complete their applications

Pay attention to application deadlines! Applications must be sent to your counselor two weeks prior to the deadline

Early Decision and Early Action candidates - make sure your counselor is aware of your deadlines

Continue working on college applications

Early Decision deadlines are as early as November 1st or November 15th!

Timeline of Senior Events: December/ January



FAFSA will be available online December 2023- complete as early as possible

Complete all college applications by December 15th if possible

Pay attention to December and January 1st deadlines. Notify your counselor of your deadlines

Check the Guidance Newsletter for scholarship opportunities

Notify your counselor of colleges that are requesting mid-year grades (for Non-Common Application schools)

Get application packet for PM Scholarships & Awards

Timeline of Senior Events: February/ March/April



Colleges will inform students of admissions decisions

Keep the counselor informed of your decision of where you plan to attend!

When you have decided on a school, send your deposit, and inform other schools so your spot can go to someone on the waiting list

Continue to research scholarship opportunities

Timeline of Senior Events: May/June

Carefully analyze your financial aid award letters

Inform the Admissions Office of the school you have decided to attend

List your acceptances and denials in Naviance for ALL colleges you have applied to

Request your FINAL transcript through Naviance
