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Dear Class of 2015 Parents/Guardians:

This year's Junior Prom will take place on Friday, May 16, 2014 from 7-11:00 p.m. at The West Lake Inn in Patchogue. As this event is quickly approaching, we wanted to communicate some very important information about student behavior and rules that students attending our Junior Prom must follow.

1. Any student caught drinking, doing drugs, smoking, under the influence, etc, will have his/her parent/guardian called and be asked to leave the Junior Prom. Students caught/suspected doing these same things before entering will not be permitted to enter. Knapsacks, purses, etc. will be searched prior to students entering the event. No refunds will be given.
2. District security will be present with alcohol breathalyzers. Any student(s) suspected of being inebriated may be asked to submit to a breathalyzer test. Refusal to cooperate, either in the administration of the test or taking of the test and/or any registered reading will result in immediate removal and/or non-entry into the event. No refunds will be given.
3. All students attending the Junior Prom are expected to dress appropriately.

4. All students attending the Junior Prom are expected to attend school for the entire day of the Prom. This is outlined in the Parent/Student Handbook (p.16).
5. All students attending the Junior Prom must arrive by 8 p.m. that evening. Students arriving after 8 p.m. will not be permitted to enter. No refunds will be given.
6. All students attending the Junior Prom (and their guests) must bring high school photo ID with them in order for them to be permitted to enter. This is outlined in the Parent/Student Handbook (p. 41).

7. Although the Junior Prom will take place off of school grounds, the rules of the school still apply and must be followed by all students in attendance, as this is a school-sponsored function. Disciplinary action will be taken if school rules are not followed.
8. Attending the Junior Prom is a privilege, not a right. Students' discipline records will be checked prior to this event, and those students with six suspensions (ISS or OSS) or more for the second semester will not be allowed to attend. Student discipline records will be reviewed right up until the day of the event. This is outlined in the Parent/Student Handbook (pp.16-17).

We hope that this year's Junior Prom will be a wonderful night for all students that attend. Please impress upon your child that he/she is representing the Class of 2015 as well as Patchogue-Medford High School. As such, he/she should behave accordingly. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact us at the High School.




